Herman Gibans Fodor, Inc. as Architect of Record, was responsible for carrying out the renovation of a 12,000 square foot downtown office, conference, and printing facility. HGF worked closely with the owner and general contractor to develop a phasing plan which assured that construction did not effect Bowne's seven-day-a-week operations. The project included the addition of a new stair, upgrading mechanical and electrical systems, and the insertion of new skylights on the roof.

The program of spaces included several new conference rooms, reception area, customer service areas, customer lunch room/bar, administrative offices, open office work areas, and staff lunch room. The main public area is highlighted by a two-story skylight atrium with a mahogany and granite reception desk. All corridors and conference rooms are decorated with custom designed mahogany cornices, chair rails, bases and door frames with clear, and frosted glass side-lights.
