

TRINITY LUTHERAN CHURCH Cleveland, Ohio



Trinity Lutheran Church, located in the Historic Ohio City District of Cleveland, Ohio, was founded in 1853 and the present church building was constructed in 1873. HGF was retained to assist the congregation in making improvements to the church building in preparation for Sesquicentennial Celebration of the congregation's founding in 2003.

The church's facilities improvement program includes broad ranging improvements to the building and property as well as the construction of an addition that will house church offices, meeting spaces, and educational rooms. HGF spearheaded a comprehensive study of the needed improvements including historic restoration, asset preservation, life safety issues, and accessibility for the disabled. The first work items to be implemented include: repair of the church roof, gutter and downspout replacement, replacement of the entry doors, restoration of entrance stairs and handrails, as well as the restoration of the foyer and narthex.
